

Competition Terms and Conditions:
KFM and Lottostar

1. General:

- 1.1. In addition to the standard Lottostar Terms and Conditions (“Ts&Cs”), which can be found at <https://lottostar.co.za/terms-and-conditions>, the Promotional Ts&Cs, available at <https://lottostar.co.za/promotional-terms-and-conditions/>, and the KFM Standard Terms and Conditions for Competitions available at <http://www.kfm.co.za/general/competition-rules> the below Ts&Cs also apply for the May Money Madness competition conducted on behalf of Lottostar.
- 1.2. The competition is only open to participants 18 years of age or older.
- 1.3. Participants are required to be in possession of a valid South African Identity Document.
- 1.4. Only one entry per participant is allowed, this entry is linked to an ID number.
- 1.5. Lottostar will not accept competition entries that are:
 - 1.5.1. automatically generated by computer;
 - 1.5.2. completed by third parties or in bulk;
 - 1.5.3. have been altered, reconstructed, forged or tampered with;
 - 1.5.4. incomplete.
- 1.6. Competitions are not open to employees, agencies, prize sponsors or contractors of Lottostar or any person directly or indirectly involved in the organisation or running of the competition, or their immediate family members.
- 1.7. The May Money Madness competition (consisting of three separate weeks, being, Beat the Bomb (week 1), Dream Catcher (week 2) and Super Sic Bo (week 3)) will take place on KFM on weekdays only and airs from 06h00 to 19h00, from 13 May 2019 to 31 May 2019.
- 1.10. The judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- 1.11. Lottostar does not accept any responsibility if you are not able to take up the prize.
- 1.12. The winners of this competition, agree that Lottostar may use their name, image and town of residence to announce any winner of this competition and for any other reasonable and related promotional purposes. of residence in the nature of a statement/invoice of account (rendered by a City Council or a bank in the case of mortgaged property) and proof of bank account details (which statements shall not be older than 3 (three) months) All documents must be furnished within 5 working days of the request for the documents. Should you have failed to comply with the provisions of FICA then Lottostar shall be prohibited from paying the prize money to the winner.

2. Week 1 – Beat the Bomb

- 2.1. Entries for week 1 – Beat the Bomb competition will open on 6 May 2019 and close at 15:00 on 17 May 2019.

- 2.2. Execution moments will take place on KFM on weekdays only and airs from 06h00 to 19h00, from 13 May 2019 to 17 May 2019.
- 2.3. To participate in the Beat the Bomb competition, listeners are prompted via on-air advertising to visit the station competition page, lottostar.co.za or the direct landing page competition URL www.kfm.lottostar.co.za. A Lottostar banner will direct them to the competition landing page. Here they will be required to fill in and submit the following: competition answer, name, surname, ID number, phone number, email address and accept the Ts&Cs.
- 2.4. The competition answer pertains to the competition question, being: “name any lottery event that you can bet on, on lottostar.co.za”.
- 2.5. The prize will be a R 5 000 (five thousand Rand) cash prize which will be payable to the entrant who is randomly selected from those who answer the competition question correctly. The winner of the R5 000 (five thousand Rand) is then asked to select a lottery ball from the “Beat the Bomb” sheet, from numbers 1 – 27. The sheet has 10 bombs which must all be avoided in order to win the R200 000 prize (if the participant is an active Lottostar player). Players are able to cash out at any point before selecting another ball.
- 2.6. If a listener is not an active Lottostar player for purposes of the Beat the Bomb competition (as is defined in clause 2.8 below) he/she will be asked to participate in the game to see what they could have won should they have been an active Lottostar player.

To participate in the “Dream Catcher” competition offered by Lottostar, listeners are prompted via on-air advertising to visit the station competition page, lottostar.co.za or the direct landing page competition URL www.kfm.lottostar.co.za. A Lottostar banner will direct them to the competition landing page. Here they will be required to fill in and submit the following: competition answer, name, surname, ID number, phone number, email address and accept the Ts&Cs.

- 4.2. Execution moments will take place on KFM on weekdays only and airs from 06h00 to 19h00, from 27 May 2019 to 31 May 2019.
- 4.3. To participate in the “Super Sic Bo” competition offered by Lottostar, listeners are prompted via on-air advertising to visit the station competition page, lottostar.co.za or the direct landing page competition URL www.kfm.lottostar.co.za. A Lottostar banner will direct them to the competition landing page. Here they will be required to fill in and submit the following: competition answer, name, surname, ID number, phone number, email address and accept the Ts&Cs.
- 4.4. The competition answer pertains to the competition question, being: “name any lottery event that you can bet on, on lottostar.co.za”.
- 4.5. The prize will be a R5 000 (five thousand Rand) cash prize which will be payable to the entrant who is randomly selected from those who answer the competition question correctly. The winner of the R5 000 (five thousand Rand) is then told that the “Super Sic Bo” dice will be rolled. For purposes of the “Super Sic Bo” competition, three dice will be rolled. The values that the dice land on will then be multiplied. There are 40 unique possible multiples of 3 dice. Each possible multiple has a value between R500 and R500 000. If the participant is an active Lottostar Player (as defined in clause 4.7 below) they will also win the value attributable to the multiple of the dice that is landed on. For clarity purposes, the outcome of the dice is determined by an independently certified Random Number Generator (RNG).
- 4.6. If a listener is not an active Lottostar player for purposes of the “Super Sic Bo” competition (as is defined in clause 4.7 below) he/she will be asked to participate in the dice roll to see what they could have won should they have been an active Lottostar player.
- 4.7. For the purposes of the “Super Sic Bo” competition an “active Lottostar player” is defined as someone who has made at least a single paid bet on the “Super Sic Bo” event offered on www.lottostar.co.za on or after 24 May 2018. For the avoidance of doubt, a free bet (Freebie, Promo credit and/or Voucher) does not constitute a bet for the purposes of being considered an active Lottostar player.
- 4.8. In the event that a participant is contacted, for any reason whatsoever, prior to the live on-air moment, such participant’s status cannot be changed. For the
